These opportunities provide our youth with positive and meaningful work experiences and connect them with the thriving community of San Francisco.

Employ youth through Job Bank

- Hire a young person for any job: one-time gigs or long-term part-time roles.

Host a youth for an internship

- Host an intern for six weeks, mid-June to late July, 75 hours total.
- We do all the administrative work (onboarding, payroll, etc).
- Typical contribution is \$2500 per intern; we work with sites and their giving capacity.
- Be connected to a Job Coach who's supporting the intern throughout the program.
